



LEAF/LEAFLETTE LEG PLACEMENT INSTALLATION


Leaf and Leaflette units are joined together by wood or metal legs which act as the connectors. The shared leg itself is designed to span between a lounge chair and a table.

Pictured from the underside of a generic configuration, Figure A represents where the Leaf/Leaflette legs are placed for the illustrated configuration.

Figures B and C illustrate a complete arrangement which shows how single legs attach to the lounge and table as well as how a shared leg is placed between 2 units. A common misconception is that four legs are required per unit, however, that is not the case when units are ordered for ganged configurations.
